The guest speaker was Dr. Diane Severance, Director of Dunham Bible Museum. Her program was titled "The Bible and the American Revolution". She shared information about many of the related items held in the collection. Candy Rudy, Hospitality Chair, presented her with a specially made pumpkin.

Secretary, Mary Beth Brunson presented the minutes for the March 27, 2025 meeting. They were approved as presented. Chaplain Marci Pounders presented her report.

The Executive Board recommends the adoption of the bylaw changed as presented. All items were adopted. With the adoption of these changes, we will need to change Article 11 to remove "relatives of the members" to match our newly changed bylaws. A notice of this proposed change will be sent out now and in 30 days we will vote electronically on this changed. Jean Kanter presented the recommendation and provided the rationale for the changes.

Fund raising projects were discussed. A possible live auction to be held at the State Convention in 2026 for 3 penny quilts. Mary Beth Brunson has donated a quilt for the fundraiser. The winning ticket will be drawn at the State Convention in 2027. Tickets will be available for sale now. Funds will be used to purchase another item for the SAR Museum in Louisville, Kentucky.

A reminder that the SAR State Convention is April 16-19, 2026, in Austin. We will have an opportunity to hand out programs for the ceremony at the Texas State Cemetery on Saturday morning. At the evening banquet, we will host a photo booth for all attendees.

A multitude of door prizes were given out to end the meeting.
