February: The Month of Presidents

In February of 1776 the cannon from Fort Ticonderoga had just arrived outside of Boston after a very difficult 300 mile haul. A 25 year old bookseller named Henry Knox accomplished the remarkable task with the help of hundreds of men en route. The cannon were placed around Boston and they hastened the British withdrawal on March 17.

Our country has long celebrated George Washington's birthday on February 22. In the 1960's the Presidents' Day holiday was created by combining Washington's and Lincoln's holidays.
