Unacceptable Documentation

- User-submitted family trees or information found on on-line websites, including GEDCOMs, Ancestry.com,
 World Family Tree, Rootsweb.com and similar sites or from personal outline family pages.
- 2. LDS Ancestral File and/or IGI records.
- 3. US and International Marriage Records from Ancestry.com.

- 4. Documents so illegible that the applicant has had to write in the pertinent information.
- Unpublished transcriptions of Wills or other legal documents posted on-line.
- Quotes from sources regarding military service posed in on-line family trees.
- 7. Photographs with names of other information entered by the applicant to show lineage.
- Un-sourced newspaper articles are not acceptable proof.


