Bicentennial Celebration of Major General Lafayette's Triumphant Return Tour to America



Corrections/Additions to the Constitution and Bylaws

Constitution

- 1. Spelling, etc. were corrected
- 2. Added in Article V "The Executive Committee shall meet at least four times per year as scheduled by the President.
- 3. Officers term of office is two years.

Bylaws

- 1. Article III Election of Officers The President's term of office is now 2 years. The President may serve three consecutive terms. After waiting one two-year term, the President may serve again.
- 2. Officers terms of office are now two years and may serve as long as they desire.
- 3. Officers are expected to attend all meetings. If more than two meetings in a row are missed, their office will be forfeited. For any forfeiture, the Executive Committee will vote on a successor and the membership in attendance at the next meeting will vote to confirm the selection.
- 4. Any officer failing or unable to perform his duties in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws may be replaced by the Executive Committee.
- 5. In Article IV under "Presidential Appointments", the following designations were changed to "Committee" from an individual classification: Community Service, Veterans, DAR, ROTC, and Eagle Scout. The person appointed to the committee will be the Chairman of that committee.

Additional Information

Per Tom vanFossen, NSSAR and TXSSAR designations are now to be NSAR and TSAR respectively. National has decided to drop "Society" from its name.
