


Gary Lynn Snowden

Born on February 21, 1957, at Florence Nightingale Hospital in Dallas, Texas, was called home on February 5, 2025. He was the son of Curtis D. and Loreta Mitchell Snowden and is preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Alan Snowden. Gary is survived by his nephew, Alan Snow-

den and his wife Samantha; his nieces, Chelsea Evans and her husband James, and Carolyn Quinlan and her husband Dennis; as well as a host of extended family and friends. A proud graduate of Skyline High School, Class of 1975, Gary earned degrees from Texas A&M University and The University of Texas at Arlington. He was on long-term disability from the Boy Scouts of America, having served as a District Executive for local councils in Ardmore, Ok, Amarillo, and Abilene. An accomplished Eagle Scout, Gary was also a Vigil honor member of the Order of the Arrow, reflecting his commitment to scouting and community service.
