The meeting was called to order at 12:00 pm by the acting President Dr. Gary Sisson.

John Young spoke about John Dillinger (1930's bank robber in the midWestern United States). In January 1934 President Roosevelt did not like being 2nd to John Dillinger in the newspaper. Dillinger was later killed by FBI agents in Chicago.

This will be subject to verification of PO Meador's qualifications as outlined in the SAR Handbook.” Seconded by Wade Graves This motion passed, after which we were dismissed.
